Purpose

This study day offers members of IFICs Intermediate Care and Polypharmacy SIGs an opportunity to share their knowledge and experience in planning, designing and delivering Intermediate Care and polypharmacy services in different systems. The study day is scheduled as a preconference knowledge exchange event for delegates travelling to the ICIC19 conference in San Sebastian April 1-3. Onward travel to San Sebastian is possible by direct train from Sants central station in Barcelona or by direct flight from El Prat main Barcelona airport.

Hosts

The study day is hosted by a consortium of partners from Catalonia and is coordinated by IFIC Scotland on behalf of the SIGs, and in collaboration with Advantage JA on the prevention and management of frailty (advantageja.eu)

Format

Presentations and discussion will be in English. The sessions will be framed around the journey of care for an older person with complex social circumstances, multimorbidity and frailty. Delegates will share, compare and contrast the different models of care and support, and the associated experience and outcomes, for patients and carers in different systems. The programme will include guided visits to an Intermediate Care facility and to a Primary Care facility in central Barcelona.
