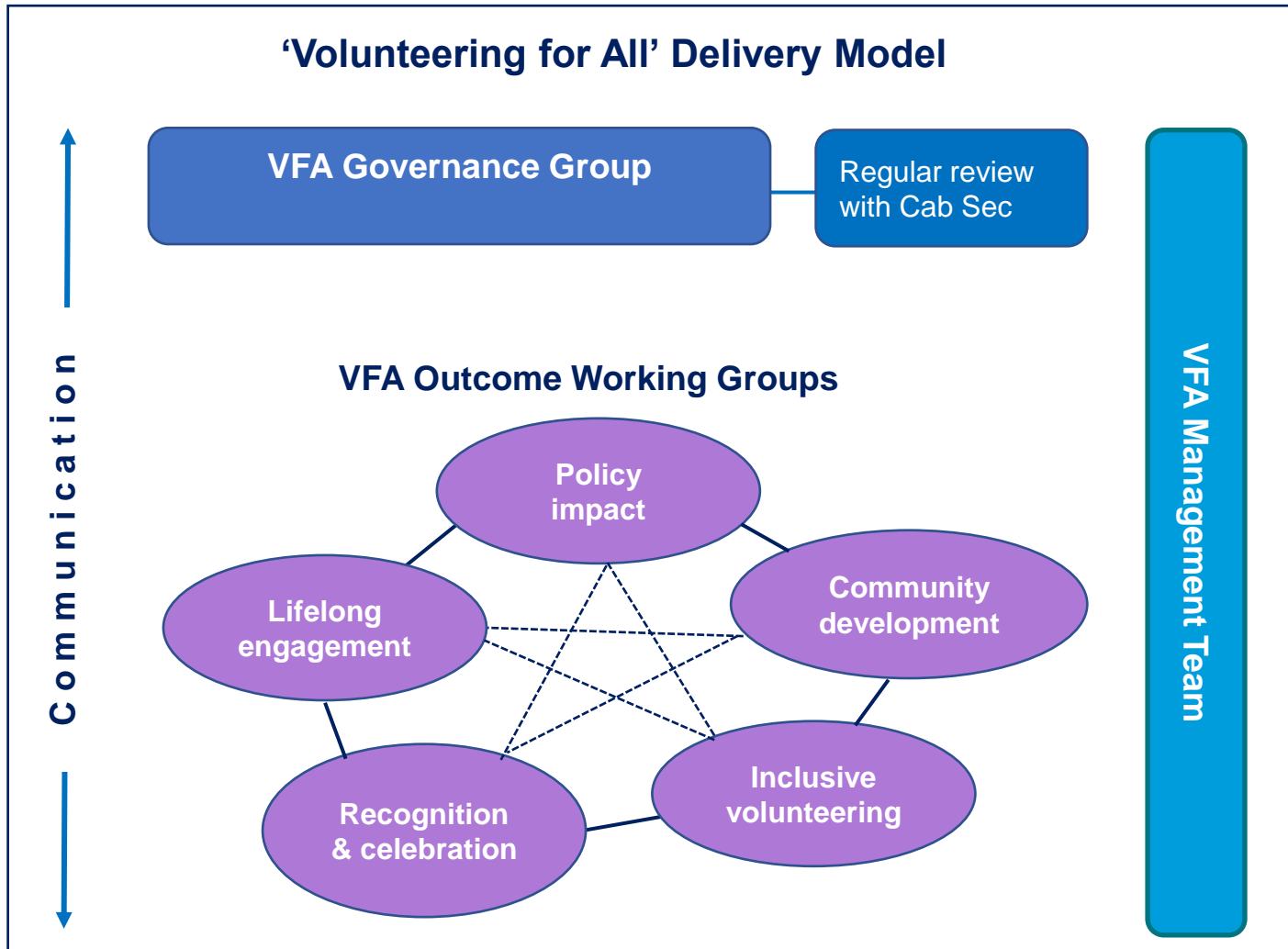

- Project goals rather than system goals
- Time bounded – specific start and end dates
- Monitoring and evaluation to determine project 'success'
