- Curious about Google Jamboards

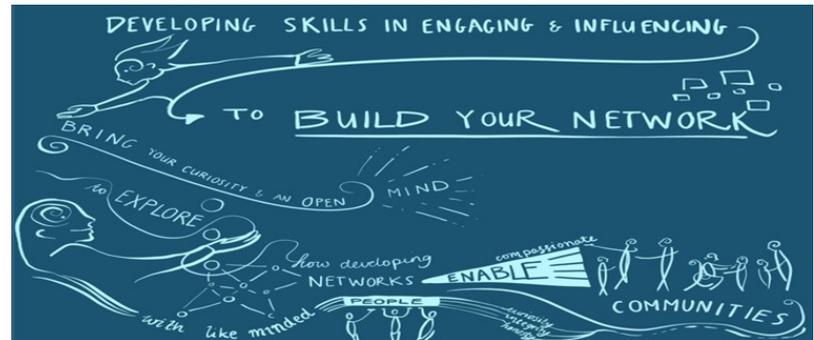
